Based on the information obtained from our investigation into this matter, it is apparent Ernest Flagler-Mitchell used his standing in the community as a Pastor, Rochester Fireman or as a County Legislator to continually seek out women on various social media platforms.

Based on our interviews and records obtained, it was common for Flagler-Mitchell to contact women he knew and didn't know to attempt to start up conversations. If a woman engaged in conversation with Flagler-Mitchell, he would immediately change the content of their conversation to flirting or sexually related topics. Shortly after this occurred, many of the women stated Flagler-Mitchell sent unsolicited images and or videos of his penis being exposed to them. Some of the women indicated they were shocked by his behavior and ended their conversation with him. However, some of the women related they began to have consensual sexting type conversations with Flagler-Mitchell, in which they sent sexual images back and forth with him. Some of these women indicated they then began having consensual sexual relations with Flagler-Mitchell because he gave them money, or paid their bills. Some of the women stated they ended their relationships when he stopped providing them with money.

It was also learned Flagler-Mitchell was very persistent with the women he met as many related it was very difficult for them to end their communications with him concerning his pursuit of having sexual relations with them. For a variety of reasons, the overwhelming majority of the women interviewed do not wish to come forward in this matter in the same fashion as the 19 year old complainant and [REDACTED]

On 12/21/2020, Investigators Boccardo and Dennis were assigned this confidential investigation. In sum, we learned that the allegation concerned a member of the Monroe County Legislature reportedly sending an unwanted photo of his penis to a 19 year old female. The female was identified to us as Lakaya Sinclair, and the alleged perpetrator in this matter is Ernest Flagler-Mitchell. On this date, we were able to have a zoom meeting with complainant Lakaya Sinclair at about 1:00 p.m.

During that roughly half hour interview, we confirmed with Lakaya the substance of her complaint, as noted above. In sum and substance, Lakaya Sinclair reports the following. On September 18th 2020, there was a mass shooting at the complainant's home in the City of Rochester on Pennsylvania Avenue. Two days after that, there was a gathering at a nearby park which in part was attended by community members including office holders. Sinclair reports that this was when she first met the suspect, who she commonly refers to as "Mr. Ernest". During this encounter, the suspect presented himself to (V) as a Monroe County legislator. (V) reports that she and the suspect exchanged facebook information with each other during that one and only time when she met him in person. (V) states that part of her reason for sharing facebook information with (S), was to showcase her work as a photographer, and her desire to get more photography work/jobs.

In the month of October, Ernest Flagler reached out to (V) via facebook messenger, and part of the conversation concerned her desire to obtain financial aid at Monroe Community College. "Mr. Ernest" reportedly said he could help her with that, though Lakaya states that never came to fruition. There were four or five times when they communicated in this fashion, which she described as sporadic. (V) described some of the contact by (S) as "flirty". The first contact that she described as inappropriate was on/about October 14th, 2020. The suspect was aware of the victim's date of birth because of the aid desired by (V) for financial assistance for MCC, and then he indicated that they were both Capricorns. Lakaya said that the suspect commented to her that Capricorns were good at everything, and he repeated everything, in that instant messenger conversation. Lakaya reports that her part of the conversation pertained to MCC, and a desire for additional photography work.

On November 24th, 2020, Lakaya reports that she sent a message to Flagler that she was interested in doing some photography work at his upcoming public speaking events. The suspect responded that he was engaged in "self love", and he asks her if she wants to see. Moments thereafter, Lakaya reportedly received the photo from him which depicted an exposed male from the waist down, showing his penis. The male depicted was grasping onto his penis in that photo, according to Lakaya Sinclair. She was asked if she thought the photo was in fact of "Mr. Ernest", and she said that she had no prior observation of him like that so she couldn't say for certain, but Miss Sinclair summarized that this was likely a picture of him. He was depicted in what appeared to be a bedroom, laying on a bed. The suspect then asked her what she thought, and Lakaya said that she thought this was weird. He apologized after that and deleted the post. Sinclair reports that the suspect deleted the photo, and she no longer has that. Note that the complainant did provide to Chief Inv. Dominic the saved instant messenger conversations that she had with Ernest Flagler-Mitchell.

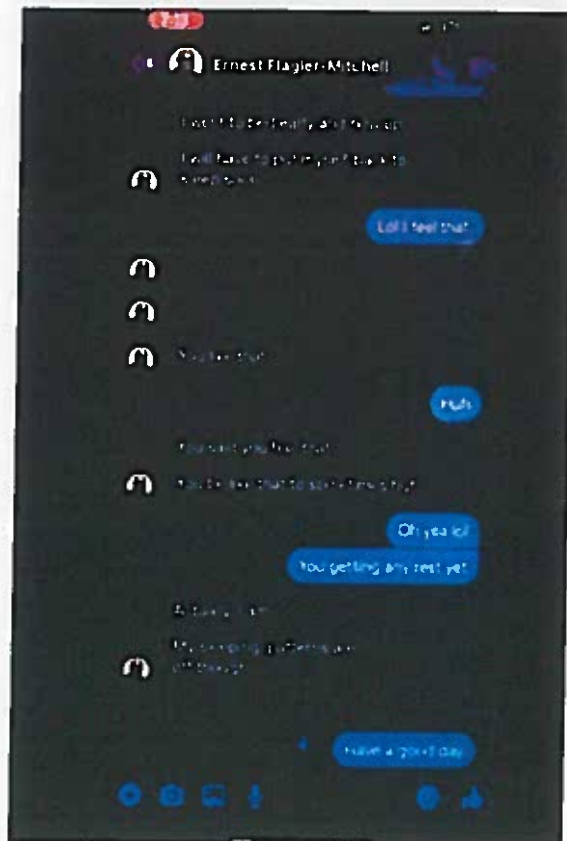
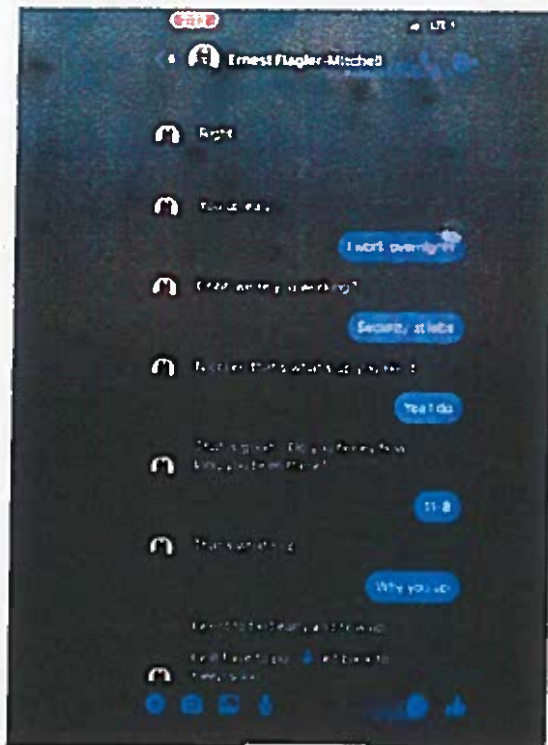


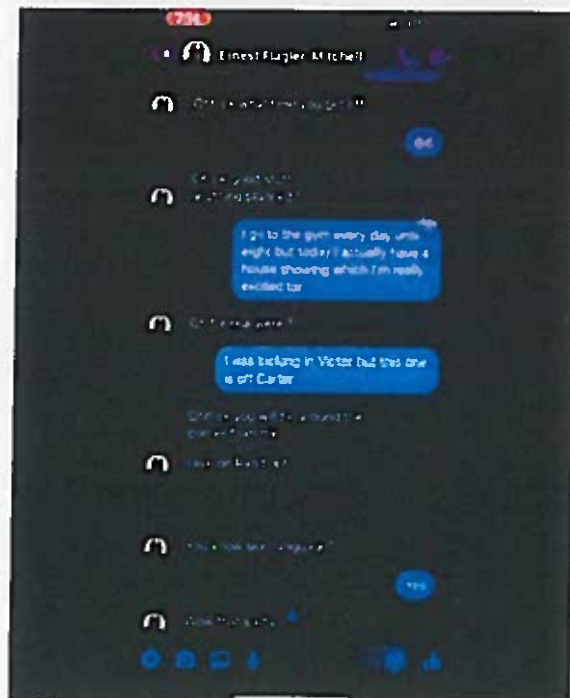
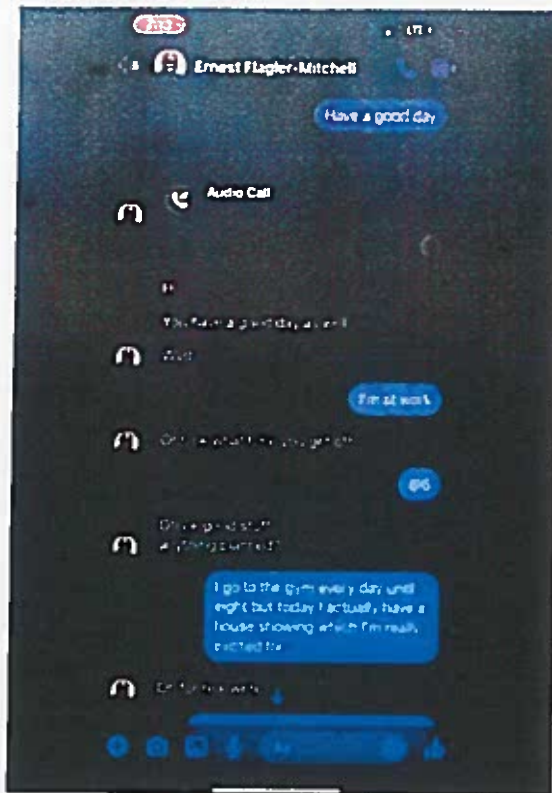


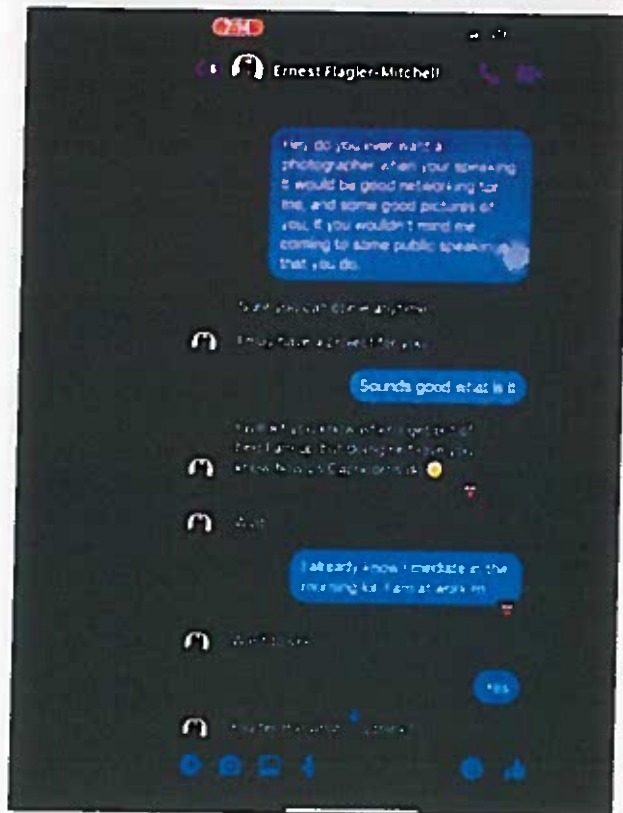
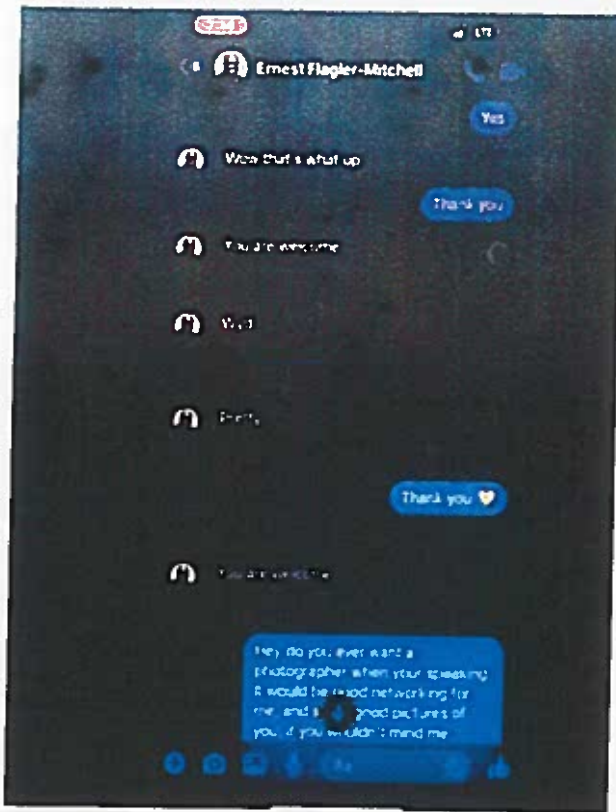


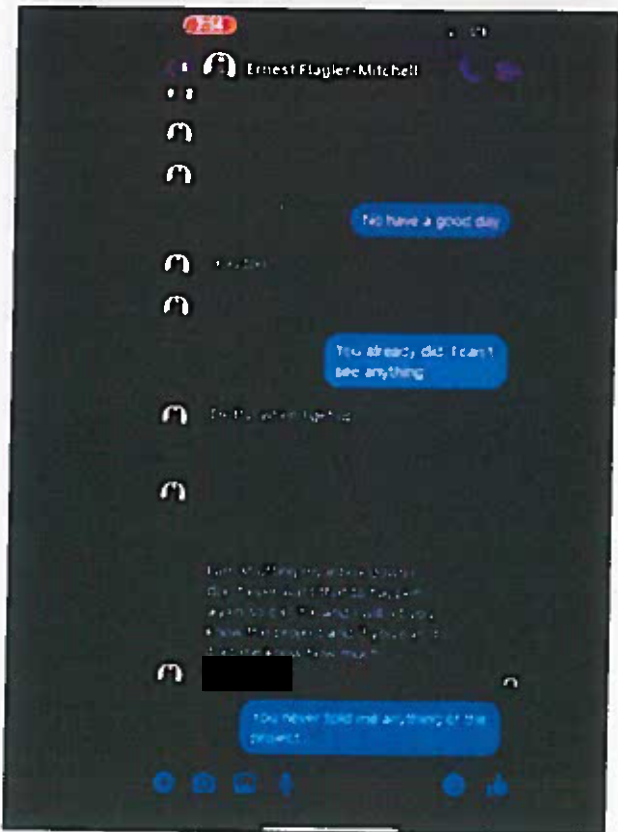
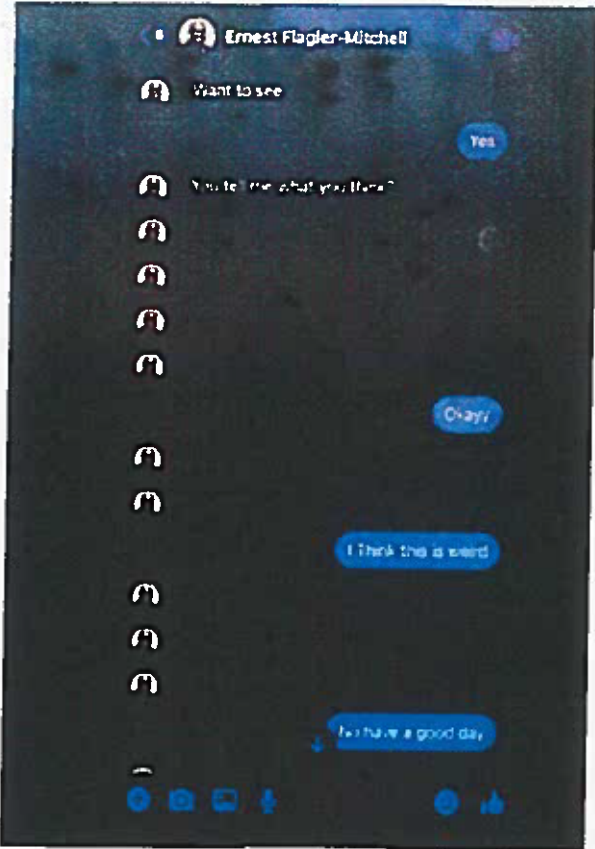












On, December 23, 2020 at about 5:00 PM, Chief Investigator Charles Dominic, Investigator Boccardo and Investigator Dennis met with Lakaya Sinclair at the Monroe County District Attorney's Office for the purpose of conducting a controlled telephone call to Ernest Flagler-Mitchell.

On December 23, 2020 at about 5:39 PM, under the direction and control of Investigator Boccardo and Investigator Dennis, a telephone call placed from Lakaya Sinclair's cellular phone to Ernest Flagler-Mitchell's cellular telephone number [REDACTED].

Upon speaking with Flagler-Mitchell he stated the following in sum and substance about the picture he had sent Lakaya Sinclair on November 24, 2020;

In the beginning of the call, Flagler-Mitchell immediately with being prompted apologized to Sinclair, stating he didn't mean to send the picture to her and he was embarrassed about sending it. Sinclair then asked Flagler-Mitchell if she did or said anything that would make him think it would be okay to send that type of picture to her. Flagler-Mitchell responded, "No" and related the picture wasn't meant for her, it was actually meant for his wife. He stated they (he, Sinclair and his wife) were all talking at the same time and he mistakenly sent her the picture instead of sending it to his wife. When he realized he done so, he stated he was embarrassed and didn't know what to do. He further stated he would never do something like that to her. Then next talked about Sinclair doing a photo shoot for Flagler-Mitchell's daughter. During this conversation, at Investigator Boccardo's direction, Sinclair asked Flagler-Mitchell if it was really him in the photograph he sent her. Flagler-Mitchell responded "No."

As their conversation continued, they spoke more about the photo shoot, Sinclair's school loans at Monroe Community College and other general conversation.

Prior to ending the call, Sinclair asked Flagler-Mitchell if she needed to worry about receiving anymore other weird photographs. Flagler-Mitchell stated she didn't have to worry about that happening. At Investigator Dennis's direction, Sinclair asked Flagler-Mitchell why he hasn't called call her about what had happened. Flagler-Mitchell again stated he would have talked to her if she had called about it, but he was embarrassed because the picture wasn't meant for her. He further indicated he has a daughter her age.

The telephone call lasted approximately 9 minutes. The entire phone call was audio recorded and subsequently burned to a disc.

Ernest Flagler-Mitchell interview on 1/05/2021

On Jan. 5th, 2021 in the afternoon hours, Sr. Inv. Renee Nicholls and I were tasked with locating Ernest Flagler-Mitchell, in hopes of conducting an interview regarding this matter. We went to his home address at 354 Randolph St., Rochester NY, where we observed a van running in the driveway with an occupant in the driver's seat. We walked up to the vehicle, both of us on the driver's side. The operator spoke to us through the open window and he confirmed that he was Mr. Flagler-Mitchell. We identified ourselves as investigators from the District Attorney's Office, and Mr. Flagler-Mitchell proceeded to have a conversation there with us. No one else was in the van with him. The conversation was recorded by us, and the recording should be referred to for further details. The conversation lasted roughly 20 -25 minutes.

At the onset of our conversation, I advised Mr. Flagler-Mitchell that a complaint came to our office from a person by the name of Lakaya Sinclaire. I identified her as a 19 year old girl, and initially he didn't seem to recall her by name. As the conversation continued, Ernest Flagler-Mitchell indicated he knew who we were speaking about, after we described her as someone he met at a vigil at a park, following the mass shooting on Pennsylvania Avenue. I explained that Lakaya reported that she had received "an inappropriate picture" from him. Flagler-Mitchell immediately acknowledged that she did, that he was supposed to send it to his wife, but he sent it to her (Lakaya). Flagler-Mitchell said that at the same time as his communication with Lakaya, he was also texting his wife. Flagler-Mitchell said that he spoke with Lakaya and said that the picture wasn't meant for her, and Lakaya said that she was glad that they cleared the air.

I asked if the picture was of him, and Flagler-Mitchell said initially that he didn't wish to get into a discussion about that, noting that he had been having a personal conversation between him and his wife. Flagler-Mitchell said that he shut down his instant messenger immediately after sending the picture, when the girl responded that this was "weird". Flagler-Mitchell claimed that he thought he had been texting his wife when he sent the picture to the complainant.

Inv. Nicholls explained that there seemed to be some innuendo, when there was a question posed to Lakaya as to whether she wished to view a picture. Flagler readily claimed that the picture he meant to send Lakaya was a picture concerning black elected officials who had been helped by David Gantt. He proceeded to show us that picture that he claimed he meant to send Lakaya, and Inv. Nicholls took a photo of the one Flagler displayed to us. He said that the "mistake" happened that night because he had been communicating with both his wife and Lakaya at the same time. Flagler-Mitchell added that his wife was out of town that night, that she was away in Charlotte N.C. for two weeks.

He was asked about the "self love" comment that he sent to Lakaya Sinclaire, and Flagler-Mitchell said that comment (just like the photo) was meant for his wife. Flagler-Mitchell was

questioned about his comment about both he and Lakaya being Capricorns, and some of the other text (self love, want to see?) that was on the printed page referred to by Inv. Nicholls during this interview. Ernest Flagler-Mitchell said that he could see how the girl got "mixed up". He acknowledged that his wife is not a Capricorn. He admitted that Lakaya's date of birth was on facebook. I asked if he thought the girl may have been trying to "hit on him", and he responded that he "didn't think so, that it wasn't like that". Flagler-Mitchell said that if she did, he wouldn't have paid that any attention, adding that she's the age of his daughter. He proceeded to say that this appears to be a case where somebody is trying to force her to do something against him. He pointed out that he hadn't done anything illegal, that he was in his own house when the complainant came into his space. He recalled it being ten o'clock at night when this communication first took place, that his wife knows about this, and so do his kids.

During the interview, Flagler-Mitchell acknowledged that both he and Vince Felder had conversed with Lakaya about helping her with MCC., and he (Flagler-Mitchell) was potentially interested in the complainant doing some photography work. Flagler-Mitchell commented that Lakaya had told him she was glad that they cleared the air (in the subsequent phone call), and he looked up that conversation on his phone and determined that it happened on Dec. 23rd (the date of the controlled call with Lakaya Sinclair). Flagler-Mitchell commented that he and the complainant were still both friends on facebook, and if he had done something that she didn't like, she would have unfriended him on facebook. He confirmed that the complainant's remark had been it was "weird" (the response on instant messenger). This is what caused him to realize on the night in question that he had sent her the inappropriate photo. He attributed that to being "mixed up" in his conversation. Inv. Nicholls continued to challenge Flagler-Mitchell about specifics (self love, both being Capricorns, etc.) from the instant messenger copy that she referred to at his car window, the printed text from the instant messenger. The audio recording should be referred to for specific details.

Flagler-Mitchell was referring to the conversation with the complainant on December 23rd 2020, when he reports telling her that the inappropriate picture wasn't him. We talked about this further and then he disclosed to us that his son "had his thing on the internet". He added that his wife wanted to see what he (his son) put out there. He explained that a sibling of the son who did this, sent Flagler-Mitchell a screen shot of the inappropriate picture. Flagler-Mitchell explained that this was the photo that he mistakenly sent to Lakaya. He told us he didn't want to talk about this initially with us because this got deeper into his family. Ernest Flagler-Mitchell said that if he ever needed to, he would put a statement out that an inappropriate picture had been sent out, that it wasn't meant for her, and that he apologized.

Ernest Flagler-Mitchell added that a person by the name of [REDACTED] was trying to take him out. He went on to say that a friend of his told him that they are trying to force her (Lakaya) to come to a press conference about this matter. Ernest said he didn't know why he [REDACTED] didn't like him. He identified [REDACTED] as the [REDACTED] of [REDACTED]. Flagler-Mitchell commented that he didn't think the complainant was out to get him.

Subsequent to the recent return of requested data from facebook concerning the investigation into the actions of Ernest Flagler-Mitchell, Inv. Kevin Dennis and I obtained a still color photo from Nov. 24th 2020 at 13:07 u.t.c.. This photo depicts an erect penis, being grasped onto by a hand. This is consistent with what was described by complainant Lakaya Sinclair from communication she had with Flagler-Mitchell that same date via facebook messenger, at about 14:01 u.t.c. The photo from that precise time (14:01) was deleted and not recovered with the search warrant. The photo obtained from 13:07 u.t.c. pertained to communication between [REDACTED] and Ernest Flagler-Mitchell.

On Thursday Jan. 28, 2021, complainant Lakaya Sinclair made herself available for us to further interview her about this investigation, and to show her the photo described above from Nov. 24th 2020 at 13:07 u.t.c. We met with her at [REDACTED], Rochester NY, and she joined us in the un-marked car at about 10:45 a.m.

Before showing Sinclair the recovered photo, Lakaya mentioned that she recently spoke with two different females who reportedly received unwanted messages from Ernest Flagler-Mitchell. She identified one of them as [REDACTED], but she did not identify the second. She told us the second female may not wish to be identified to authorities. Both women have reportedly been interviewed by D&C reporter Wil Cleaveland, according to Sinclair. The un-identified female apparently is going to check an old phone to see if it contains any information still about that unwanted communication.

Lakaya Sinclair was advised that we had a photo of an exposed penis in a folder for her to view, as part of this investigation, if that was okay with her. She agreed to view same, and I handed her a folder containing that photo at about 10:48 a.m., as she sat in the back seat of our car. Upon opening the folder and viewing the color photo, she stated aloud, "that is it". She commented that she recognizes the same "orangie wood type background". Sinclair also commented that she recalled the foot being in the photo in the left corner area of the picture. Sinclair went on to comment that the picture she viewed this date may have been "cropped" from the one she originally viewed on Nov. 24th, 2020, as the still photo in the folder did not depict something white in the top right corner that she had recalled. She thought the item in the original photo from Nov. 24th 2020 may have been a television or a computer. This was the only difference she noted.

After the viewing of this color photo, Lakaya Sinclair was asked if there were any other issues she wished to speak with us about. Sinclair proceeded to state that she had been contacted by the son of Ernest Flagler-Mitchell on Jan. 17th, 2021. This son identified himself as "H.D. Fastlane", and he reached out to Sinclair via facebook messenger and instagram. Both messages were quickly deleted by him, according to Sinclair. She reports that the sender stated, "yo, what's up

with you and my dad? You're lying". that these messages were the substance of the communication. Sinclair said that she did not respond to the messages on January 17.

We asked Lakaya Sinclair if anyone from the Monroe County Legislature reached out to her, since this complaint recently aired on the local news. Lakaya said that she has not been contacted by anyone from that organization.

Lakaya Sinclair proceeded to tell us that she spoke yesterday (Jan. 27, 2021) with Christian Garzone from channel 13 news. Sinclair said that she is not looking for any further interviews at this point.

Lakaya Sinclair was asked during this interview about what her ultimate goal was in coming forward with this complaint. She explained that she would like to see Ernest Flagler-Mitchell resign from his position as a Monroe County legislator because of his conduct noted in her complaint. Sinclair was further asked if she would want him arrested, if criminal conduct was determined. Sinclair said that would be fine, that she would agree to testify if necessary.

Today's interview ended at about 11:05 a.m., and we advised Sinclair that this matter was still under investigation.

On Feb. 5th, 2021, Investigator Kevin Dennis and I met with a [REDACTED] year old female associate of Ernest Flagler-Mitchell, who wishes to have her name "scratched out" of these reports. Her identity is known to us, but I will refer to her as CS 1 as she does not wish to have her identity known in this investigation.

At the onset of our interview, we revealed that her name came to our attention after an examination of facebook messenger records of Mr. Flagler-Mitchell. CS 1 readily acknowledged that she did have contact with him in such a fashion, and that they did in fact meet in person both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] for sexual relations. She quickly told us that she did not have any complaints about him, that she may even have initiated the early conversation with him on facebook messenger. CS 1 reports that Ernest Flagler-Mitchell is a [REDACTED] though she also knew him to be a politician.

CS 1 said that she saw the story in the news about Flagler-Mitchell, with respect to his alleged sending of an unwanted photo of himself exposed, to a 19 year old female. CS 1 said that she was disappointed by his actions in that matter, but she did not wish him any "ill will". She made the point that the times when she and he met up for sex, it was mutually agreed upon. At no time did she indicate that this was the result of any favors by him or a case of him using his position in government as a means to influence her to have sex with him.

With respect to the sending of an image of an exposed penis, CS 1 confirmed that she was the recipient of same from Ernest Flagler-Mitchell. This took place sometime after they began communicating via facebook in [REDACTED] per CS 1. When asked, she stated that she did not recall if he was standing or sitting on a bed in that picture where he was exposed. CS 1 said that she last spoke with Flagler-Mitchell the day before the above described story ran in the news, that she called him then to talk about [REDACTED] with him. Toward the end of the interview, CS 1 said that she really didn't want to answer anymore questions. She also told us that she didn't know of anyone who was a victim of unwanted contact by Ernest Flagler-Mitchell.

On Feb. 5th, 2021, Investigator Kevin Dennis and I met with a [REDACTED] year old female associate of Ernest-Flagler-Mitchell, who wishes not to be involved in this investigation. Her identity is known to us, so I will refer to her as CS 2. This woman went so far to say that if we were to speak with her outside of the confines of the interview at her home, she would respond by saying that she doesn't know what we are talking about. CS 2 added that she was confident that we would find enough people to be able to do what was necessary concerning Mr. Flagler-Mitchell.

Early in the interview, we revealed to CS 2 that her name came to our attention following an examination of facebook messenger records of Ernest Flagler-Mitchell. We further explained that our purpose was to contact female associates of his to see if they had been subjected to unwanted /undesirable contact by Mr. Flagler-Mitchell. In sum and substance, CS 2 stated that she had been the subject of unwanted contact by Flagler-Mitchell. In the same breath, she said that she did not feel uncomfortable about the contact because she is a [REDACTED] year old woman. CS 2 added that she is on better terms to deal with this than the 19 year old complainant who CS 2 observed in recent news stories. CS 2 said that she supports the actions of the 19 year old female complainant, that she is proud of this woman. Further, CS 2 said that the conduct described by the 19 year old has properly brought attention to the fact that Ernest Flagler-Mitchell does not recognize boundaries or lines, that this has been continuous conduct he has shown. CS 2 cited her basis for this statement as information she has heard "from the community", noting that she heard these reports before the 19 year old complainant came forward.

CS 2 said that she got to know Flagler-Mitchell through [REDACTED] that she met him through the [REDACTED] Inv. Dennis referenced some of the messages on facebook, and CS 2 acknowledged that she would contact Flagler-Mitchell for a legitimate matter, and then he would respond with a "different undertone and overtones". She told us that she then responded by letting him know he was crossing the line. She told us that there has not been intimate contact between the two of them.

Inv. Dennis specifically asked CS 2 if she had been the recipient of any inappropriate images. She commented that it was apparent that "little Ernest wanted to come out and play". CS 2 told us she received these images a couple of times, and she didn't know what prompted him to do such a thing. She said for her, it wasn't frightening or intimidating. CS 2 also commented that she is not intimidated by his position in government, that in no way does it have any impact on her. CS 2 said that she didn't feed in to the behavior by Flagler-Mitchell, but she could see how a 19 year old may not know how to handle the situation. She told us that she spoke with him last about a week before the story about the complainant was on the news, [REDACTED] In sum, while she applauds the actions of the 19 year old complainant, CS 2 does not want to be involved in this matter herself. On Feb. 5th, 2021, Investigator Kevin Dennis and I met with a [REDACTED] year old female associate of Ernest Flagler-Mitchell, who wishes not to be involved in this investigation. Her identity is known to us, so I will refer to her as CS 3. This woman was cooperative with our interview on Feb. 5th, 2021, but she noted that if we didn't come to her, she would not have reported anything. Further, she does not wish to be part of an ongoing investigation.

Early into the interview, we revealed to CS 3 that we learned of her identity after a review of facebook messenger records of Ernest Flagler-Mitchell. CS 3 told us that she [REDACTED] that they are [REDACTED] and Flagler-Mitchell had a [REDACTED] with a [REDACTED]. She explained that [REDACTED] for him when he [REDACTED]. CS 3 reports that they have [REDACTED] before but he was the only [REDACTED].

CS 3 told us that she saw the news reports about the 19 year old female complainant who stated that Flagler-Mitchell sent her a graphic sexual picture. CS 3 said that this happened to her once, in [REDACTED], and that it was unwanted. She characterized his facebook comments to her as "flirtatious", but she was still reportedly shocked when she received the photo of his penis. She informed us that she subsequently blocked him on facebook. She told us that she blocked Flagler-Mitchell well before the 19 year old came forward with her complaint. CS 3 said that she [REDACTED] that she [REDACTED] with Flagler-Mitchell at all. She was concerned that [REDACTED] so she blocked Flagler-Mitchell, so [REDACTED]. CS 3 said that [REDACTED] with Flagler-Mitchell on a [REDACTED] level, and that [REDACTED]. She noted that [REDACTED].

CS 3 said that when she received flirtatious messages from Flagler-Mitchell, she would try to change the subject and would not take the bait. CS 3 said she does not air her business in public, and did not share this with other people [REDACTED]. CS 3 said that after seeing the story on the news about the 19 year old female complainant, she presumed there were other women out there subjected to the receipt of penis photos besides the complainant and herself, but she does not know of a specific other victim. CS 3 felt as though the conduct by Flagler-Mitchell was very bold. In her case, she thought it was something he did as an individual person, unrelated to his position in government. In closing, CS 3 reports that she never initiated sexual conversation with Flagler-Mitchell, that the above described contact was unwanted (the photo), and she doesn't want to be part of an ongoing investigation out of fear that [REDACTED].

On February 5, 2021, Investigator Boccardo and R/I interviewed a [REDACTED] year-old female regarding this investigation. The female indicated she was willing to talk to us, but she stated she did not want name involved. Based on this fact, R/I will refer to the female as (CS 4 - [REDACTED] YOA), but her identity is known by Investigator Boccardo and myself.

Upon speaking with the female, she indicated she has known Ernest Flagler-Mitchell for a while, relating she [REDACTED]. She indicated sometime in [REDACTED], she started flirting with him via Facebook messenger after he commented on her picture and helping her [REDACTED]. From these initial communications, they continued to communicate via Facebook messenger, and eventually arranged to meet and have sexual relations. (CS 4 - [REDACTED] YOA) stated she did not have sexual intercourse with Flagler-Mitchell, but related "he liked to do other things." She stated as they built their friendship/relationship Flagler-Mitchell began to buy her [REDACTED], bring her food and give her money. When asked, she stated at first she wasn't providing sex for money, but later admitted it ended up that way. She stated this happened because she knew he was married and she needed money, so she figured why not. At first, she wouldn't confirm whether or not they sent sexual explicated pictures back and forth to reach other. However, later in our conversation, she stated when Flagler-Mitchell sent explicate pictures to her, he always asked permission prior to sending them, even after they had been together sexually.

In closing, (CS 4 - [REDACTED] YOA), related all of her communications and sexual relations with Flagler-Mitchell were consensual. With regards to him paying her for sexual relations; as previously stated this wasn't the case at first, but when she realized he was willing to pay her she charged him because she needed the money. He responded she is upstairs sleeping. (CS 5 - [REDACTED] YOA) stated they continued to communicate via messenger and consensually sent sexually related messages and pictures back and forth to one other.

(CS 5 - [REDACTED] YOA), further recalled last summer when her daughter and her drove past Flagler-Mitchell's residence, they observed him sitting on the front porch in a robe having his genitals exposed.

(CS 5 - [REDACTED] YOA), indicated she did not want to have her name associated with our investigation, but related she had seen the news regarding Flagler-Mitchell sending a solicited picture of his penis to a young woman. She stated she felt Flagler-Mitchell's were inappropriate and horrible.

Upon arriving at the location we were invited inside to talk by [REDACTED]. We next asked her if she knew Ernest Flagler-Mitchell.

[REDACTED] stated the following in sum and substance;

[REDACTED] indicated she had met Flagler-Mitchell via Facebook, indicating a few months ago Flagler-Mitchell had [REDACTED]. After that occurred, they began to chat via Facebook messenger. [REDACTED] stated at first they had general conversation and then it changed to flirting. Shortly after this flirting began, [REDACTED] stated Flagler-Mitchell sent her a photograph of his exposed penis while he was lying in bed. She stated she wasn't expecting him to send her a picture like this, but it was common for men she has spoken to online to do, so she really didn't take too much offense. She related after this occurred, they both sent sexually explicit pictures back and forth to each other during some of their conversations. [REDACTED] recalled Flagler-Mitchell also sent her a video of himself masturbating. She related Flagler-Mitchell continued to try to meet up with her, but she resisted because she knew from their conversations he was married. She stated Flagler-Mitchell invited her over to his house and asked to come to her house several times during their Facebook messenger conversations. [REDACTED] stated she never spoke to Flagler-Mitchell on the phone directly even though he attempted to video chat with her during their conversations. It should be noted Facebook records show Flagler-Mitchell sent images to [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] stated after she heard on the news about Flagler-Mitchell sending an unwanted picture to a young female she checked her Facebook messenger conversations and found Flagler-Mitchell had deleted all of the images he had sent her and most of their conversations. [REDACTED] related she thought about calling someone to let them know she had a similar experience with Flagler-Mitchell to support the girl, but indicated she didn't know who to call. She further stated she felt her situation with Flagler-Mitchell was different because she had continued to talk with Flagler-Mitchell after he sent the picture of his penis and she sent photographs of herself back to him. [REDACTED] stated she felt Flagler-Mitchell was lying about meaning to send the image to his wife instead of the girl because of how he described his marriage during their conversations.

[REDACTED] stated she would be willing to testify about her experience with Flagler-Mitchell if it is deemed necessary by our office.

[REDACTED] stated she will be contacting the women to see if they would willing to meet with Investigator Boccardo and myself to discuss their experiences.

It was determined we would re-connect with [REDACTED] on 02/08/21 to discuss her conversations with the women to see if they would be willing to at least meet with us.

We eventually determined today that [REDACTED] d.o.b. [REDACTED] no longer lives in Rochester, that she moved about a month ago to [REDACTED]. She can be reached at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] called us back this afternoon, and we briefed her on the nature of this investigation. In sum and substance, [REDACTED] said that she was already aware of the complaint aired in the Rochester news made known by 19 year old Lakaya Sinclair. [REDACTED] said that Lakaya [REDACTED] At any rate, [REDACTED] said that she does not actually know Ernest Flagler-Mitchell. She reports that he did initiate efforts to communicate with her several [REDACTED] via facebook messenger, but she wasn't sure how far back that was ([REDACTED]). She did not recall receiving any inappropriate photos or videos from him, but she said that he "creeped" her out. She was unable to provide specifics, citing the amount of time that had gone by since the contact. [REDACTED] reports that she was a [REDACTED] in Rochester when Flagler-Mitchell initiated contact with her. She believes that he was "randomly inboxing people" back then, and she recalled that he [REDACTED]. In conclusion, she did not cite any specific examples of the inappropriate contact that we have been investigating.

[REDACTED] was another name provided by [REDACTED]. We attempted to reach her by phone today, and we also went to her last known address as well on Feb. 17th. As of this writing, we have not heard back from Miss [REDACTED]. Should we have success in doing so, the results will be documented for this investigation. (120)

[REDACTED] stated after talking with her sister, and given that Flagler-Mitchell stopped helping her (giving funds), she decided to stop communicating with him. [REDACTED] stated when she did this, Flagler-Mitchell started to badger and beg her to meet up with him. She stated he stopped contacting her when she ignored his attempted communications.

[REDACTED] stated the following in sum and substance;

When she met Flagler-Mitchell he was a fireman for the City of Rochester. She stated since meeting him, they flirted a lot with each other over the phone and on Facebook messenger. She stated Flagler-Mitchell came to her house a few times while he was on duty with the Rochester Fire Department for sexual encounters. [REDACTED] described Flagler-Mitchell as becoming very bold and pushy with her during their relationship. [REDACTED] stated on a few occasions, she had to tell Flagler-Mitchell to back up because of the way he was acting. She indicated Flagler-Mitchell was the person who initiated sending images of himself exposed to her when they flirting back and forth. She stated Flagler-Mitchell also sent video chats where his penis was exposed and of him masturbating during some of their chats. [REDACTED] stated her conversations and interactions with Flagler-Mitchell were consensual, but she didn't appreciate how he would occasionally contact her at all times of the night.

[REDACTED] stated she called Layaka Sinclair (anonymously) when she heard what had happened to her regarding this case. [REDACTED] stated she made this call to give Sinclair her support and let her know Flagler-Mitchell had done similar activity to her in the past. [REDACTED] stated she felt Flagler-Mitchell was lying regarding the statement he made stating he had actually meant to send the image of his penis to his wife instead of Layaka.

On Feb. 9th, 2021, Inv. Kevin Dennis and I were assigned to interview [REDACTED] after communication was recovered recently, between [REDACTED] and Ernest Flagler-Mitchell. Ernest Flagler-Mitchell has been the subject of a recent investigation after sending a lewd photo to a 19 year old female.

Inv. Dennis and I were able to ascertain a home address for [REDACTED] from his parole officer, that being [REDACTED]. We stopped there in the morning hours on Feb. 9th and were advised by a male who answered the door that [REDACTED] was out for a brief period. Inv. Dennis left that male with a business card & cell #.

A short time later, Inv. Dennis received a call from a person identifying himself as [REDACTED]. The telephonic conversation was recorded by Inv. Dennis; [REDACTED] did not want to meet with us in person. In sum and substance, [REDACTED] was very annoyed that we stopped at his house and he demanded to know how we found out his address. We eventually disclosed to him that we intercepted communication between him and Ernest Flagler-Mitchell, and we had a few questions for him about comments he made during that communication. Specifically, we were interested in who the "higher up" was in the police department that reportedly shared information with him, and we also wished to know if he had a specific issue with the District Attorney.

[REDACTED] said that we can tell District Attorney Sandra Doorley that she, along with the other assistant DA's, will see him in court when he goes on the record. He also named former asst. D. A. [REDACTED] as he vented about being framed and convicted for a crime that he claims he didn't commit. [REDACTED] directed us not to come to his house again and said that he would construe that as harassment and he would then follow the proper procedures. He said that our visit to his home constituted a threat. [REDACTED] specifically said that a D.A. investigator fraudulently forged information that contributed to his wrongful conviction. He complained that we violated his constitutional rights by coming to his house, that we violated protocol, and that he didn't do anything illegal. He told us that he is oppressed by individuals because he is black and because he is an activist.

We tried to direct the conversation to his previous comment about a higher up in the police department that he claimed to have spoken with, as noted in the conversation with Flagler-Mitchell. He pointed out that we were not internal affairs, that he essentially didn't trust us or the District Attorney. [REDACTED] said that it would put him in jeopardy if he spoke with us. Hence, he has reportedly already spoken with someone from the Attorney General's Office and he has already or will be trying to reach the governor. We tried to pin him down about what he actually knew in terms of wrongdoing by someone. He never got into that. [REDACTED] said that he went to Ernest Flagler-Mitchell for assistance because Flagler knows people who can protect him, and who can assist him. [REDACTED] said that Flagler never got back to him. [REDACTED] said he has been sitting on his information. *DD*

██████████ mentioned to us that he recently met with Undersheriff Korey Brown, and on his facebook page after our interview, he explained that he spoke with Brown when ██████████ was an inmate, that they spoke about doing a podcast. At any rate, we pointed out to ██████████ that if he had a trust in the Undersheriff, he could speak with him or his parole officer about the information he was sitting on. Inv. Dennis also noted to ██████████ that he had Kevin's business card, and if he wished, he could call back in the future to speak with us.

In closing, ██████████ was seemingly annoyed throughout the phone interview. He did not provide any information of substance, but he did once again state that he does have documents that show financial issues and he has proof of his claims. He never identified anyone from a police department who he reportedly spoke with (a "higher up"), and he also noted that this higher up was also a high ranking member of the union, which did not make sense. On Weds. Morning Feb. 10th 2021, I briefed parole officer Danielle Contreras on the substance of our interview with ██████████, and confirmed with her that we were not bringing any new charges against him. The recorded interview with ██████████ can be referred to for further details. EJP
